Improvements and fixes

This update contains security and reliability improvements.

This security update also contains fixes and improvements for the following nonsecurity issues in SharePoint Server 2016:

- Improves the performance of certain database operations that are done by the SharePoint Products Configuration Wizard (PSConfig), Timer service jobs, and other features.
- Fixes an issue in which you receive the following error message when you try to clear a filter by using indexed columns in a SharePoint list that has many items: **Cannot show the value of the filter. The field may not be filterable, or the number of items returned exceeds the list view threshold enforced by the administrator.**
- Fixes an issue in which Web Parts that depend on **WPPProperty** don't work correctly. To enable the Web Parts to work, you have to also follow the steps that are provided in [KB 5003528](#) to declare the affected .NET types to be allowed to access **WPPProperty** in the Web.config file.

This security update also contains a fix for the following nonsecurity issue in Project Server 2016. Consider the following scenario:

- On a task, you set the Status Manager.
- You publish the project.
- Later, while in the same editing session, you change the Status Manager settings.

- You publish the project.

In this situation, the Status Manager property does not get updated in reporting. Instead of reflecting the new Status Manager, the old one is still observed.

Improvements and fixes

This security update contains fixes for the following nonsecurity issues:

- Fixes an issue where metadata about the Public Update that was stored in the Windows Registry contained non-printable characters.
- Removes the engagement log query parameter "e" from copy links for On-Premises because it's only used in SharePoint Online.
- Fixes the issue in which the screen reader doesn't read the text of the Quick links web part title that's given by a user.
- Fixes the issue in which the screen reader doesn't read letters when you delete words.
- Fixes the issue where the posted news doesn't show up in the "News" web part in Internet Explorer by using the list layout.
- Fixes the role relationship issue at the "Document" page for accessibility.
- Fixes the issue in which the ARIA toggle field in details list doesn't have an accessible name.
- Fixes the issue where the **New Items** under **Site Usage** in a non-English modern team site only counts .docx files.

Note: To fix these issues, you have to install [KB 5001944](#) together with this update.
